Social Studies

This Week: Students will draw and label the three geographic features on their maps of Asia and paste the map in their passports.

Next Week: Students will explore Europe and learn about the Mediterranean Sea, the Alps Mountains, and the Italian Peninsula.

Math

This Week:. Students will learn about fractions, beginning with partitioning shapes into equal groups. They will identify how a whole can be divided into halves, thirds, fourths, sixths, and eighths.

Next Week: Students will learn how to identify and write fractions on a number line, and how to represent one-whole as a fraction.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This Week:

We began our unit on Main Idea and Supporting Details this week with our next writing assignment. Following the writing process, students brainstormed and created outlines to use for their paragraphs describing a New Year's Resolution. In Q3 we will be transitioning from narrative/story writing to more expository/informational writing, which will have students creating 5 sentence paragraphs with a clear topic sentence, three supporting details to help explain the topic, and a concluding sentence. Students will publish their final copy of their New Year's Resolution next week.
