Charlottesville Catholic School will be offering a variety of after school clubs during winter/spring (Archangel Clubs). The clubs provide our students a child-centered enrichment opportunity, possibly tapping into new and exciting areas of interest.

Archangel Clubs offered by Charlottesville Catholic School teachers begin the week of February 6 and continue through the week of April 17th, with makeup weeks being April 24th and May 1st. This provides ten weeks of instruction. *Archangel Clubs cost \$175.00, with a percentage supplying materials and then a percentage towards teacher compensation. Archangel Clubs will be billed through FACTS.*

Please note that Archangel Clubs need a minimum of 8 students in order to be held. Additionally, there is a maximum enrollment of 12 students per club. This does not apply to clubs offered by outside organizations.

What: Music club is for students in grades 3-5 who have an interest in music and singing. No prior music experience or classes required. Students will learn 2-3 songs, which they will present during the Art Show Open House in the spring.

Who: 5th-8th graders

Students will learn to embellish on printed fabric and can then bring in their own items (denim jackets, hats, pillows, cloth purses, ripped jeans, and more) to embellish with different colored designs that they choose.
