## Week in Review

#### Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students worked on their New Year's goal setting and creating powerful endings to their realistic fiction stories.

**Social Studies** 

In Social Studies this week, students began work on creating a comic strip based on what was learned in Ch. 4 of our Social Studies curriculum. We also began Ch. 5 which focuses on the American Revolution!

#### Math

In Math this week we have been focused on long division through the thousands-place. We've been reviewing strategies for division that we learned before Christmas break (distributive property/box method/partial quotients), and have enjoyed solving multi-step word problems with varying operations.

#### Science

In Science this week we transitioned from Life Science to Earth Science, and learned all about rocks and minerals, (sedimentary, metamorphic and igneous rocks) the Rock Cycle, weathering and erosion. <u>The Ch. 7 test is scheduled for Friday, 1/21.</u> The study guide, and key concept questions from lessons 1-4 can be found on the Science Google Classroom.

#### Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on how to love God, ourselves, and others in our study of the 10 Commandments and the Precepts of the Church. We enjoyed learning about our "Partner in Faith" for Unit 3 L 13, Saint Louis of Toulouse, and are striving to be faithful disciples in our everyday lives. Today we took the Unit 3 Lesson 13 quiz.
