

Social Studies

This week in SS, students finished up chapter 4 which focuses on what life was like in the early days of the Virginia colony. Students learned about how vital tobacco was to the economy, the living situations of Virginians, and the different positive influences that other cultures have made on our society. The chapter 4 test is currently scheduled for Thursday, January 23. Study guides were given out today.

Next week, we will begin chapter 5 which focuses on the American Revolution!

Math

This week in Math, we continued to look at equivalent fractions using both number lines and models to compare them. We also did our MAP test. The students worked very hard to take their time and use the strategies they have learned so far.

Next Friday is the math test on comparing equivalent fractions.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in LA, students started learning about poetry. We are learning about different types of poems, their structures, and how to read them. Students focused on poems such as "Journey to Be" and "The Railway Train". This was a lot of fun and very engaging!

Next week, we will continue this unit and take our Reading MAP test.

Theology

This week in Theology, we worked on reviewing for our quiz and discussed our experiences with Baptism and first communion. We also worked on our tenet of the month posters and did our qualifying round for the Catholic Bee. I will reach out to those who qualified next week.

Science

This week in Science, we Learned about the way the earth moves, the moon, and planets. We also did a tasty lab using oreos to replicate the phases of the moon.
