Math

Our super second graders will continue with the theme of addition next week as they begin a unit on three-digit addition. So proud of the very grown-up math these sweethearts are tackling!

Please also continue to practice math fact fluency daily by using flash cards, calling out problems, rolling dice, or even using cards. Your Sloth or Cheetah can teach you!

Literacy

Ready for take-off! Our fluency flocks are diligently working to improve intonation, raise reading rate, and emphasize expression as they read aloud. When reading at home, encourage your radiant reader to read like an actor!

Nifty nouns! We'll conclude our study of nouns next week, focusing on nouns in a series and possessive nouns, both singular and plural.

Splendid spellers! After checking in on spelling growth, we're reorganizing spelling groups to tailor instruction to each of our Cheetahs and Sloths. Spelling will resume in February with gusto!

Peppy puppeteers! Next week, our dramatic darlings will begin lovingly creating puppets in Art (we love collaborating with fabulous Mrs. Devlin!) to complement a script writing project in our classrooms. The Sloths and Cheetahs will perform their puppet shows for Junior Kindergarten on February 17! The Sloths will perform for Ms. Shank's class and the Cheetahs will perform for Ms. Wawner's class.
