Math

Thank you for continuing to support your child's automaticity with math facts by practicing daily at home!

This week, we completed our Telling Time unit with a test on Friday. Students did a fabulous

job learning how to tell time to the nearest 5 minutes, identifying the half and quarter hours, and problem solving questions about time.

Moving forward, we will be exploring the world of data, particularly tally charts, frequency tables, and picture graphs!

Literacy (Reading / Writing / Spelling)

Second graders love reading! We're excitedly beginning new novels in reading groups and enjoying lots of read aloud time! We love connecting reading to both student interest and second grade Social Studies/Science content.

In writing, The Praying Puppies and Holly Jollies continue their study of verbs, expanding beyond action verbs and diving into helping verbs. They have also reviewed spelling change patterns when adding the suffix "-ing" when using the proper verb tense.

Spelling will resume next week! Thank you for supporting your lovely learner at home with the homework choice board activities.

Science / Social Studies

In Science, we continued our study of inventions and innovation by reading nonfiction texts about the innovations in telephones, calculators, televisions, toothbrushes, and clocks. The Praying Puppies and Holly Jollies were shocked by how primitive the world was when their parents and teachers were young! Haha! These readings are in Friday Folders and are a great resource for practicing re-reading.

In Social Studies, the Holly Jollies and Praying Puppies are learning about the contributions of influential Americans. This week, we learned about Martin Luther King, Jr. and Rosa Parks. Next week, we will learn about Thurgood Marshall, Jackie Robinson, Helen Keller, and Cesar Chavez.
