Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students worked on their realistic fiction stories and learned about a few classic poems as well!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students continued Ch. 5 which focuses on the American Revolution. Students learned about the Intolerable Acts, Boston Massacre, and Patrick Henry!

Math

In Math this week we learned about patterns and sequences involving numbers, figures and symbols. We enjoyed discerning rules of various pattern sequences to solve for missing terms.

Science

In Science this week we learned about soil formation, and various types of soil. We learned about soil horizons, and how soil formation is due to processes that we previously learned about, like weathering and erosion. We were able to hone in on our independent study skills in preparation for the Chapter 7 test we took today.

Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on the effects of Original Sin, temptation and our inclination to sin, and types of venial sin. We studied the stories of Adam and Eve's temptation in the Garden of Eden, and the temptation Jesus resisted in the desert.
