Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students began our unit on the American Revolution! We focused on the beginning of the revolution with the French and Indian War. Students are taking time to learn the "why" of the American Revolution to properly understand how a war could happen.

Next week, we will continue this unit!

Math

This week, the kids enjoyed learning about input/output tables with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division rules. We were able to detect rules within the table so as to continue the pattern and learned how to create equations for given functions.

The Chapter 7 Math Test is scheduled for Thursday, February 2nd.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students began "Because of Winn Dixie" as well as a writing unit in which we will focus on how to write realistic fiction stories.

Students have been focusing on stories that we wish existed in the world and how to create stories from ordinary moments. We will continue this work next week.

Religion

In religion this week we took our Unit 2 Lesson 10 quiz about our Sacraments at the service of Communion, and the domestic church. The students learned the songs for the Passion Play and auditioned for parts. We spent time in class reviewing for our Unit 2 Test, and 4B began Mass preparations for next week. The Passion Play parts will be announced next week.

Science

Students have enjoyed learning about different types of rocks, and the rock cycle which changes rocks over long periods of time. We learned about ways weathering and erosion affect rock formation, soil formation, and landforms, and also learned about ways soil composition affects vegetation. The students are enjoying a fun and engaging project of choice about the rock cycle.

Rock cycle projects are due on Tuesday, 1/31. The Ch. 7 Science test is scheduled for Wednesday, 2/1. Please ensure field trip permission slips are signed and returned to school by February 1st.
