Catholic Schools Week is next week. Don't forget to wear your uniform on Sunday for Mass.

During Catholic Schools Week, we will dedicate time to being stewards of our neighbors near and far by holding a food drive for the Blue Ridge Area Food Bank (BRAFB), and also by holding a penny drive for The Alyssa House. The BRAFB provides emergency food assistance in the Blue Ridge region, serving 25 counties and 8 cities, with distribution centers in Charlottesville, Lynchburg, Winchester, and Verona. Over 100,000 people receive emergency food services each month.

The Alyssa House, named for 10-year-old Alyssa Divers, provides free housing to families of children in medical crisis who are receiving extensive care at the University of Virginia Children's Hospital. Social Studies

Students say prayers and the Pledge of Allegiance each day. We are learning about famous black Americans.

Math

We continued our Math Journals this week. Each day we graph the weather for the day, add a number to our calendar, draw a circle in our 180 day ten frame chart, and color in a number in our 100s chart. We composed and decomposed numbers up to 10. We continued subtraction. Please have your child practice counting by ones, fives, and tens to 100.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We did activities related to The Jacket I Wear in the Snow. We continued fluency passages. Each passage focuses on a particular word family, consonant blend, or digraph. Please have your child read these passages to you at home. Students are learning to blend sounds to read consonant-vowel-consonant words. Please continue to practice sight words at home. Students are working on pencil grip and writing on the lines. Students are learning the structure of Daily Five. As we send books home, please have your child point to each word and read the book three or more times. We are working hard to help students build independence by approaching tasks with the following guidelines: get started right away, work the whole time, stay in one spot, work quietly, build your stamina.

Religion

We read a Bible story each day, prayed and talked about how God led the Israelites to the promised land. We also have a science related devotion each day and we are learning a lot about God's amazing world. Catholic Schools Week is next week. Please wear your uniform to Mass on Sunday.

Science

We made Chinese New Year Dragons on Tuesday using popsicle sticks. We also made volcanoes using baking soda and vinegar on Thursday.

In Music, students did some ice skating to understand half notes, quarter notes and eighth notes! It was so much fun!
