Math

The Praying Puppies and Holly Jollies are thoroughly enjoying our new unit on Data Analysis. We've been taking surveys, recording data in tally charts, transferring data to both picture and bar graphs, and analyzing the data with problem solving opportunities. Next week, we'll tackle line plots!

Keep up the good work with math fact fluency at home! A few minutes a day goes a long way!

Literacy (Reading / Writing / Spelling)

Second graders love reading! We're working on decoding unfamiliar words using base words, prefixes, and suffixes; reading rate; and reading with intonation. It's wonderful to see our readers grow and set new goals!

Science / Social Studies

In Social Studies, the Holly Jollies and Praying Puppies are learning about the contributions of influential Americans. This week, we learned about Thurgood Marshall, Jackie Robinson, Helen Keller, and Cesar Chavez. Next week, we will turn our attention to Abraham Lincoln, Christopher Columbus, Benjamin Franklin, and George Washington Carver. We'll connect both Benjamin Franklin and George Washington Carver to our study of innovation and invention in Science!

Students learned this week how praying is talking and listening to God. Even moreso, they know that God *always* hears and answers our prayers by either telling us "yes," "not now," or "I have something better." Our time in the chapel this week showed how clearly the children internalized all they learned about prayer as they reflected on those that they could pray for and how to reverently be present to Our Lord.
