## Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students worked on their realistic fiction stories and learned about a few classic poems as well!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students continued Ch. 5 which focuses on the American Revolution. Students learned about the Declaration of Independence, how different groups contributed to the war, and Thomas Jefferson!

Math

In Math this week we focused on word problems with patterns and sequences. We have also been focused on input/output function tables with addition, subtraction, multiplication and division rules, created equations for these function tables, and learned all about the order of operations.

Science

In Science this week we learned all about different types of landforms, and what causes changes to Earth's surface. We learned about fossils and what they can tell us about previously existing organisms and climates.

In Religion this week, 4th grade received their Passion Play scripts. We had our auditions, and roles will be cast next week. We will also begin read-throughs of the play. This week we enjoyed learning about different types of sin. We learned about ways to reject temptation, and how to open our hearts to conversion and repentance after committing a sin.
