Math

This week we started our geometry unit. Next week we will focus on measuring angles, classifying quadrilaterals and triangles, and finding perimeter.

Science

This week we began our rock and mineral unit. We will be creating sandstone rocks and making crystals in our labs and also working on rock and mineral properties and characteristics.

Social Studies

This week read about the Revolutionary War and watched Liberty Kids to connect to our reading. Next Week Students will review the Revolutionary War by completing a Choice Board as our Unit project.

Language Arts

This week we continued reading *Love That Dog* and students took a quiz on subject complements. We also started the poetry-writing portion of this unit. Next week, we will continue to write poetry, will have a test on the figurative language spelling words, and will have a test on *Love That Dog*.
