## **Social Studies**

We talked about Catholic Schools week during our social studies time and wrote letters to our families thanking them for sending us to a catholic school.

# Math

This week we continued our unit on place value. We compared numbers up to 120, used mental math to add and subtract 1 and 10 with numbers up to 120, and added multiples of 10 to a 2-digit number using manipulatives. Next week we will continue with our unit on place value.

# Language Arts/Reading/Writing

#### Reading

This week we read the book *Cloudette* by Tom Lichtenheld and learned about describing character traits using text evidence to support those traits. We also learned about inference and that when readers infer, they use evidence from the text plus their background knowledge to figure out what the author hasn't directly told us. Next week we will read *The Darkest Dark* by Chris Hadfield. We will also learn about nonfiction text purposes.

### **Grammar**

This week we reviewed punctuation and the job of each type of punctuation in a sentence. Next week we will review the suffix -ing.

#### Writing

This week we continued to develop our writing by incorporating previously taught skills (i.e., verb tense, punctuation, and descriptive adjectives). We had the opportunity to practice writing in a Fiction-style (a little more fun and creative) as well as a Nonfiction-style (sticking to the facts). We also completed writing activities in our Daily 5 rotations such as journal/story writing

and dictation of sentences.

# Theology

This week we wrapped up our unit on the Sacraments with an assessment. Then we played 3 corners using the Sacrament categories as our corner names - initiation, service, and healing. There were, also, some great bonus opportunities for theology during Catholic Schools Week, including a visit from Fr. Dan Hesko to give students a talk about vocations, a living rosary, Adoration and a faith rally! What a great week to be in Catholic school!

## Science

We focused on Social Studies this week.
