Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be exploring the events surrounding the Revolutionary War.. We will present our historical bios on February 3rd.

Math

Students will be learning to multiply fractions and simplify (reduce) their answers.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 3rd quarter requirements are to complete Math: 5th grade for Coordinate Planes (unit 12), Line Plots (unit 15) and Multiplying Decimals (unit 8).

**All students need to be checked off for their multiplication facts 0-12 and xx by the end of 3rd quarter.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week students had a quiz on the list of spelling/vocabulary words based on figurative language. They also wrote rough drafts of the remaining poems for the poetry unit, and finished reading *Love That Dog.*

Next week, students will continue discussing *Love That Dog* and begin the second reading, focusing on figurative language. They will also study prepositions in grammar, and we will analyze rhyme schemes in poetry. We will also start our next spelling/vocabulary unit, which will be on Greek and Latin roots and affixes.

Theology

This week, students continued learning about the hierarchy of the Catholic Church, and we participated in many great activities for Catholic Schools Week.

Next week, we will continue with our unit on the structure of the historical foundations of the Church and its hierarchy. Students received a study guide for this material, and took notes. The quiz on that material will be on Tuesday (rescheduled from this week).

Science

We completed a lab on cleaning water with a degree of success, but not enough to sample our results. We will begin our unit on rocks and minerals.
