Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students learned how to become expert readers by paying attention to the things that matter the most in stories and to pay attention to the descriptions of characters and settings in a story.

Students will also continue their nightly reading logs next week. This will be in their homework folder. Students are expected to read and fill out their reading log nightly Monday through Friday.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students began chapter 1 of our textbook. We are learning about the 5 geographic regions of Virginia and what makes them unique.

We will have a test over Chapter 1 on Friday (10/8).

Math

In Math this week we have been focused on subtraction across multiple zeros, and creating multi-step equations with variables for word problems. We have enjoyed practicing our addition and subtraction fluency with regrouping through the hundred thousands place.

There will be a test on Chapter 2, Tuesday, October 5th.

Science

In Science this week we began Chapter 2. We have been studying traits, heredity and genes. We did an introductory lab exploring inherited characteristics (hitchhiker thumbs and earlobes) to better understand the difference between inherited and learned traits. We also learned all about photosynthesis and plant life cycles.

Religion

In Religion this week we took our quiz on Unit 1 Lesson 4. We have been focused on the Resurrection, the Assumption, the Immaculate Conception of Mary, and the Final Judgment. 4B did a wonderful job working hard to plan Mass. Additionally, we enjoyed learning about St. Padre Pio and St. Timothy, and working on our Last Judgment mini-projects.

There will be a Unit 1 Lesson 5 Religion Quiz on Thursday, October 7th. There will be a Unit 1 Test on Tuesday, October 12th.
