Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We are going to be learning about the first English colonies in North America.

Students will be tested on sections of the United States. Students need to identify each state and write the correct name and its capital. To make this more manageable, students will only be learning one section at a time. The **Rocky Mt. Region test** will be on Thursday, October 17th. Students need to identify the correct state by shape/location and be able to write the state and capital name (spelling and capital letters count).

Math

We are reviewing multiplication, partial products, exponents and multiplying with zeros. We will be multiplying 3 digit by 2 digit numbers. Students will continue to be tested on their multiplication facts (0-12, xx). The Unit Review test will be on 10/14. We will begin working on multiplication with decimals.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 2nd qtr. requirements are to complete *Get ready for multiplication and division with whole numbers and decimals* (unit 4) and *Get ready for powers of 10* (unit 6). Students will work on Khan Academy as part of their extended math time.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued discussing and analyzing *Wonder*. We also continued working on correcting run-on sentences, and had a test on the dictionary. Because of the number of quizzes and tests next week, the quiz on run-on sentences will not be next week but will be early the following week.

The first quarter IRA is due on Monday, and students will have a test on the first half of *Wonder* on Friday. We will continue to review run-on sentences in anticipation of of the quiz the following week.

Theology

We continued our study of the Rosary this week, and students began memorizing the Apostles' Creed. There will be a quiz on the Apostles' Creed next Wednesday.

Also next week, we will be doing our fall lesson from the *Empowering God's Children* program. That will be next Thursday.

Science

Our next unit is on ecosystems. We will be making oxygen in an upcoming lab. We will also be making a conservation project using empty 2 liter bottles. Please send in any empty 2 liter bottles if you can.
