# Science/Social Studies

Students celebrated the season of fall this week by learning about why leaves change color and going on a leaf peeping expedition where we collected some of our favorites. We also talked about how animals start to prepare for the winter months. Next week, we will start our unit on apples and pumpkins. Ms. Shank's class continued our study of Fall and continued our study of nocturnal animals. We studied bats. We will begin our pumpkin and apple unit focusing on the life cycle.

### Math

Ms. Wawner's class started learning about teen numbers. We focused this week on what the 1 means at the beginning of teen numbers and how 10 is a part of each number. We did this by learning the slide method. We also started learning about how to show teen numbers on a ten frame. We will continue to practice teen numbers next week. Ms. Shank's class will also begin

working on our teen numbers and one to one correspondence. We will finish our unit on sorting next week. I will begin remediation groups.

# Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the letter N this week. Next week, we will review the six letters we have learned thus far through reading, writing, and review games. We will also start an author's study of Tomie DePaola. Ms. Shank's class read about bats. We read the story "Stellaluna" about a fruit bat and sequenced the story. We also reviewed our letter and the sound of S, A, T, and P. The students are still not confident in hearing the letters in the beginning sound of words.

# Theology

Ms. Shank's class continued our study of the Bible hero David. We read some Psalms and talked about the different types of Psalms. Ms. Wawner's class learned the story of Noah and his Ark this week. We created an ark poster with animals and a rainbow to commemorate the story. We talked about how following God like Noah did is good, but not always popular. We also made our own arks out of play-do and blocks to help us act out the story.
