### **Social Studies**

This week we completed the project chart for the 13 English Colonies project. On Tuesday, October 18th, there will be a test on the 13 Colonies (see p 181). Next week we will be studying some key Puritan figures in their quest to secure religious freedom.

#### Math

\*We will be working on mastering our multiplication table 0-12 and doubles by the end of the 1st quarter. Please practice the basic multiplication facts at home or in the car coming to and from school. Knowing your multiplication facts is a vital skill that students will be needing for success in math in school and in daily life.

\*Students will need to complete (mastery level) Khan Academy *Decimal place value* by the end of the 1st quarter.

This week we reviewed multiplication of 3 digit by 2 digit. problems. Next week we will review fact families, practice 4 by 2 multiplication and the work on the steps used in solving long division problems.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued reading and annotating *Wonder* and worked on revising the draft of the personal narrative. One element we will work on in the narrative is punctuating dialogue. This week students were given resources on how to punctuate dialogue in their papers, but they will also have a quiz on that material next week. Students will also receive a new set of spelling/vocabulary words next week, but the test on those will be the following week. Next week, students will also turn in the revised draft of their personal narrative, and we will work on the editing stage the following week.

## Religion

This week we focused on praying the Rosary. As part of this unit, students are memorizing the Apostles Creed, and there will be a quiz on the Apostles Creed next week.

### Science

We will have a science test on classification on Monday, 10/17. Students completed a study guide that they should be reviewing. We will be learning about ecosystems and doing an oxygen lab this week.
