Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students wrote an alternate ending to "The Tiger Rising"! This was such a fantastic experience and it was fun to see their creativity on display!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students sharpened their map skills and continued to learn how to use nonfiction texts properly.

Math

In Math this week we have been working on foundational skills for multiplication and division. We have been focused on factors and multiples, properties/rules of multiplication and division, and word problems containing multiplicative/additive comparisons.

The Chapter 3 test is scheduled for Wednesday, 10/20.

Science

In Science this week we finished Chapter 2, and have been focused on physical and behavioral Animal Adaptations (Chapter 3).

Our Adaptations project is due on Monday, 10/25. This project is to be worked on at home.

Religion

In Religion this week we have enjoyed learning about the parts/order of the Mass. We began Unit 2- "How does God share his life with us", and reflected on ways we share in God's life through the sacraments, and in various other parts of the Mass.

There will be a quiz on Unit 2 Lesson 6 on Tuesday, 10/19.
