## Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students worked on creating "debatable" questions from "The Tiger Rising" and learned about the themes that the story had.

In Social Studies this week, students began Ch.2 which focuses on the different Native American tribes of Virginia.

#### Math

This week in Math we took our Chapter 3 test. We were focused on factors and multiples, and word problems with reasonable/unreasonable answers. We began Chapter 4 and got to dive further into multiplication. We learned the zero property of multiplication for multiples of 10, 100 and 1,000, and how to round to estimate products.

#### Science

In Science this week we have been focused on adaptations (physical and behavioral), plant and animal fossils, and extinction. Students should complete their adaptation projects this weekend and bring them to school to turn in on Monday (Poster and packet).

Our Adaptations project is due on Monday, 10/25. This project is to be worked on at home. There will be a Ch. 3 test on Tuesday, 10/26.

### Religion

In Religion this week we learned the difference between sacraments and sacramentals, discussed various sacramentals in our homes, how we can show we are thankful, learned about the liturgical year of the Church (memorials, feast days, and celebrations), and even how to write our own psalms!

There will be a quiz on Unit 2 Lesson 7 on Wednesday, October 27th.
