Curriculum

Math

This week we began our unit on subtraction. We introduced key vocabulary such as difference, subtract, take from, take apart, how many fewer, and how many more. We also discussed how subtraction relates to addition. Activities consisted of using manipulatives, drawing pictures, and using number lines to demonstrate subtraction number sentences. Next week we will continue to review subtraction as well as addition, place value, and other math skills previously taught.

Reading and Language Arts

Reading

This week we read and discussed the story, *The Girl Who Thought in Pictures*. This book was our first nonfiction-featured story (biography - Temple Grandin). Grandin is a remarkable woman with an amazing story that can teach us about overcoming obstacles, hard work, and pursuing your passion/dreams. Our focus skills of the week were all about nonfiction text structures and how a nonfiction text can still feel like a narrative (story). Due to the short week next week, there will not be a new story. Instead we will focus on reviewing previously taught skills.

<u>Grammar</u>

This week we focused on ABC order. We completed several activities where students needed to identify and sort words. We discussed the process for organizing words based on a word's spelling/letter order (start by comparing words' first letter and then work your way to the right). Next week we will continue reviewing ABC order.

Word Study/Spelling

We practiced sorting our words, chunking syllables, identifying phonemes (individual sounds) and focused on the /j/ sound. We looked at the spelling rules/generalizations for when /j/ is spelled with a j, ge, gi, gy, age, and dge and took our weekly spelling quiz. Next week students will receive a new word sort (spelling list).

<u>Writing</u>

This week we wrote about our story, *The Girl Who Thought in Pictures*. We made connections between people, events, and ideas. Specifically, we described Dr. Grandin, her life, and her inventions/ideas as well as scientists in general. Next week will be used for additional writing practice within Daily 5 activity rotations.

Religion

This week we also completed a faithful brainstorm- writing four ways we can be faithful like Mary. We also completed a Mary true/false sort and wrapped up our unit on Mary with a Mary BINGO game. Next week, we will discuss All Saints Day and start our "My ABC Saint Book". We will also learn about Pope Francis.

Science/ Social Studies

This week we wrapped up any science work that has not been completed this quarter. We will spend the 2nd quarter working on Social Studies.

Homework (M - Th) For the week of: 11/1-11/4

Math- 1st Quarter Week 5 Math Sheet - Complete one activity each night (M - Th).

Reading- Read for 15 min./night. Please record the title of the book that was read each night. Additionally, for each completed book, your child will color in their reading log for the month (e.g.October books = candy corn). Don't forget the monthly reading challenge that was included in the binder as well. These activities are designed to motivate readers/encourage students to have fun with reading. It's optional, but highly recommended.

Word Study/Spelling- Students should sort their Word Study/Spelling words each night as well as work on **3** activities total of their choosing from the Weekly Spelling Menu (**M - Th**, 10 min./night).
