Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students worked on learning how to read nonfiction texts effectively and how to "read to learn". We practiced essential skills such as how to make connections to text, how to preview a text, etc.

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students finished Ch.2 which focuses on the different Native American tribes of Virginia and the contributions that they made.

Students will be constructing a diorama based on a Native American village starting 11/1 in class. Please have materials ready to bring in on Monday (11/1). This project will be due on 11/4. Students may work on the project at home and at school. Please contact me if you have any questions.

Math

In Math this week we have been focused on multiplication. We learned how to model multiplication in base-10, how to round and estimate products, how to use the partial product and zero strategies for multiplication, and how to multiply 2-digit by 1-digit numbers using the standard algorithm (and why it works!)

Science

In Science this week we took our Ch. 3 "Adaptations" test, and have enjoyed sharing our projects with the class.

Religion

In Religion this week, we discussed rituals and devotions of our Church. We learned about rituals in the liturgy, and of various prayers of devotion like the Stations of the Cross and the Rosary as ways to praise and give thanks to God. This week we started Unit 2 Lesson 8. We enjoyed reflecting on times when we've felt God's love and grace, and have been focused on our Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation). We are in the process of writing letters to our godparents (or others who have helped shape our faith!) and look forward to finishing/sending those next week.

Our next Religion quiz (Unit 2 Lesson 8) will be on Wednesday, November 3rd.
