Math

This week we worked on estimating quotients, using the distributive property and partial quotients in solving long division problems. We will continue to focus on long division strategies and multi-digit multiplication.

Science

We started our matter unit this week and completed multiple labs. Next week we will be focusing on the properties and states of matter. We will be doing a gas lab and matter simulation.

Social Studies
