Math

We have been working on solving story problems involving repeated addition. One way to help us solve these types of problems is to draw/use an array to model the addition number sentence. We have been using games to reinforce these skills and to reinforce previous learned number sense skills. Next week, we will learn strategies to help us solve two step story problems.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

We read <u>I Need My Monster</u> by Amanda Noll, a story about a boy who cannot fall asleep without his beloved monster, Gabe. We focused on making connections, reader's theater, sequencing the story and common and proper nouns. Students wrote a story about their own monster. Next week, we will read <u>Crankenstein</u> by Samantha Berger. We will focus on making connections, sequencing events, and quotations.

Theology

This week in theology we focused on our saints project. We researched why our saint is important, their feast day, and other important facts. During chapel, we talked about the rosary. On Thursday, we attended our first school wide prayer of the rosary.

Social Studies

We focused on Hispanic Heritage Month. We learned about some famous americans. We read stories and completed a book tower challenge in the STEM lab. Next week, we will be creating a soccer field out of supplies from the STEM lab in order to learn about some famous hispanic soccer players.

Science

We focused on social studies this week.
