Social Studies

This week in SS, students finished their first unit on the 5 regions of Virginia. We focused on the Appalachian Plateau and Valley and Ridge regions.

Next week, we will be doing a project in which students will be creating a salt dough model of the 5 regions of Virginia. This is a really fun activity in which students will learn, create, and write about the 5 regions of Virginia.

Math

This week in Math, we completed a project to propose a new playground. Students were given a budget and asked to select equipment to add to their playground.
