Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We are going to be learning about the first English colonies in North America.

Students will be tested on sections of the United States. Students need to identify each state and write the correct name and its capital. To make this more manageable, students will only be learning one section at a time. The **Rocky Mt. Region test** will be on Friday, October 18th. Students need to identify the correct state by shape/location and be able to write the state and capital name (spelling and capital letters count).

Math

We are reviewing multiplication, partial products, exponents and multiplying with zeros. We will be multiplying 3 digit by 2 digit numbers. Students will continue to be tested on their multiplication facts (0-12, xx). The Unit Review test will be on 10/14.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 1st qtr. requirements are to complete Decimal Place Value, Add Decimals and Subtract Decimals. Students will work on Khan Academy as part of their extended math time.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued discussing and analyzing *Wonder*. Students took a test on the set of spelling/vocabulary words from the first 23 pages of *Wonder*. We also started working on correcting run-on sentences. In addition, we started our short unit on the dictionary.

Next week, students will continue to read *Wonder* and will have a test on the dictionary on Wednesday. We will also continue working on correcting run-on sentences and have a quiz early the following week.

Students are also working on their first quarter IRA (Independent Reading Assessment), which is due October 14. For this assignment, they chose an historical fiction book from the library to read and then will complete a report. For this quarter, the report is a paper form, a copy of which is on Google Classroom. This is a project grade (which is weighted as heavily as are tests).

Theology

We ended our study of the Liturgy of the Eucharist and Concluding Rites, and the responses for those parts of the Mass with a test this week. We began our study of the Rosary.

Science

We have been learning about classification in science. Our test will be on 10/10. We will be playing SMITE as a review for the test.
