Social Studies

We talked about the country of Nicaragua and Hispanic Heritage Month.

Math

This week we continued working with number sense activities and counting, numeral recognition and how to write number words. Next week we will practice doing all our number sense activities up to the number 120.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

<u>Reading</u>

This week we read and discussed the story, *Hoot and Peep*, which is a fiction book that looks at two owl siblings and how it is okay to be different. Our focus was on making connections to what we read (Text to Self, Text to World, and Text to Text) while reading. Next week we will read *If Your Monster Won't Go To Bed*.

<u>Grammar</u>

This week we looked at onomatopoeia- a word that mimics the sound of the actual thing or person described. Next week we will look at adjectives.

<u>Writing</u>

This week we wrote about owls and focused on the type of sentences we were writing (asking and telling) and punctuation that was needed. We further practiced our writing skills during Daily 5 writing activities.

Religion

This week we read a story about Mary and completed various activities like a KWL chart, a story square and a coloring page. Next week we will continue our unit on Mary.

Science

This week we continued learning about matter and completing activities in our science interactive notebook.
