Math

We continue to work on number sense, until our students have a solid understanding of numbers 0-20. Number sense is critical to all future mathematical concepts and operations. We watch videos about numbers, and practice writing and counting. We are also working on sequencing numbers.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Both classes studied the letter I this week. We created the letter I with play-do, dot paint, and even our bodies! We practiced tracing and writing them on our own. We also reviewed the

letters that we have learned so far and talked about how we can already make words! Ms. Wawner's class sounded out sat, sap, pat, and tap! Next week, Ms. Wawner's will learn about the letter N. Ms. Shank will be reviewing the letters we learned so far and completing an assessment of those letters.

Religion

Ms. Wawner's class continues to learn about the importance of prayer and practice saying The Lord's Prayer, The Hail Mary, and The Glory Be. We will also be learning about the things the students see at Mass and signs and symbols of our faith.

Science

Ms. Wawner's class wrapped up exploring the five senses by learning about touch. We learned to identify items that are rough, smooth, hard, and soft. We went on a texture walk and had fun guessing what items were in the mystery box by touch alone. Ms. Shank's class learned about owls, (barn owls, screech owls, burrowing owls, snowy owls), and their habitat. We also talked about owl adaptations. The students watched as Ms. Shank dissected an owl pellet.
