Math
This week we worked on estimation and multiplication of multi digit numbers. Our next focus will be on long division with remainders.
Science
We learned about the classification system for living organisms. We will be looking into the connection of energy moving through organisms and ecosystems, and the relationship among food chains, food webs, consumers, producers, decomposers.
Social Studies
This week we finished the simulations for a colony, and next week we will learn about the colonists in the three regions. Students will have a test on colonial life next Friday.
Language Arts
This week students worked on revising their short stories and on possessive nouns. We decided to reschedule the possessive nouns quiz until next Wednesday and do a final review of the topic on Tuesday. Students also received a new list of spelling/vocabulary words this week, so we did several activities with those. The quiz on those will be early the week of the 18th. The short story is due next Thursday, and students need to turn in the rough draft, the revised draft, and the final draft on that day.
