### Teacher's Message/Announcements

 <u>Charlottesville Catholic School will present a sexual abuse prevention program, the</u> <u>Teaching Safety – Empowering God's Children program, to our students next week.</u> The creators of the Protecting God's Children<sup>®</sup> program developed the Teaching Safety – Empowering God's Children program. This program is required by the Catholic Diocese of Richmond as outlined in the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People as a part of our ongoing effort to help create and maintain a safe environment for children and to protect all children from sexual abuse.

One lesson per semester will be presented to all students at Charlottesville Catholic School. Each lesson will be approximately 45 minutes in length and will cover "Boundaries: You Have Rights," and "Secrets, Surprises, and Promises." We encourage you to read the *Teaching Boundaries and Safety Guide* so that you are aware of the nature of the *Teaching Safety – Empowering God's Children* program. To ensure the school and family connection remains strong, we will communicate the exact date of each lesson prior to the lesson being taught (**First Lesson - Tuesday, 10/29**).

### Social Studies

**This Week:** Students will be learning about the geographic features of South America. They will explore the Amazon Basin, which includes the Amazon River and Rainforest.

# Science

**This Week:** Students will begin working on their project on drawing and labeling the parts of an animal and plant cell. Students will learn what plants need to live through our observations of planting their seedlings and noting in a log each week any changes which may have occurred to their plants.

**Next Week:** Students will complete their plant and animal cell poster, and continue observing and measuring the growth of their seedlings. They will learn the process of photosynthesis and the different types of plants.
