# Curriculum

#### Math

This week we continued with subtraction and looked at key vocabulary such as difference, subtract, take from, take apart, how many fewer, and how many more. We also used strategies/instruction with manipulatives, drawing pictures, and using number lines to demonstrate subtraction number sentences. Next week we will dive even deeper into subtraction with strategies such as breaking apart and thinking about addition and how it relates/can help with subtracting.

### **Reading and Language Arts**

#### Reading

Through our main story of the week, *Maddi's Fridge*, as well as supplemental readings, we made valuable connections (text to text and text to world) and explored ideas of friendship and charity. We also examined how to read a website while discussing internet safety. Next week we will read the story, *Plump and Perky Turkey*, and focus on asking questions as readers and summarizing skills (Beginning, Middle, and End).

### Grammar

This week's focus was on common nouns vs. proper nouns. We addressed the need for proper nouns (specific names of people, places, and brands) to be capitalized and compared nouns like school and Charlottesville Catholic School. Next week we will target adjectives and use them to describe characters from our stories and people and things in our writing.

### Word Study/Spelling

We practiced sorting our words, chunking syllables, identifying phonemes (individual sounds) and focused on the /z/ sound. We looked at the spelling rules/generalizations for when and why /z/ is spelled with a z, zz, and s. We also reviewed previously taught spelling patterns and skills. Next week students will receive a new word sort (spelling list).

#### Writing

This week we included proper nouns into our writing as we wrote about friendship and ways to help one another. We also wrote within Daily 5 activity rotations and in other content areas such as Social Studies (Veterans Day), Religion (Giving Thanks), and morning work tasks. Next week we will be working on summaries as well as focusing on adjectives to help describe/bring color to our writing.

### Religion

This week we continued learning about Saints. We learned about St. Francis of Assisi and discussed the traits of Saints. Next week we will continue learning about saints and will learn about St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. We will also discuss being thankful.

### Science/ Social Studies

Our focus this week was on Veterans Day and honored all of our veterans. On Thursday, we participated in a CCS Veterans Day tradition. We planted flags, listened to a guest speaker - Veteran Tom Craig (Mrs. Devlin's Father), and spent time discussing and reflecting on the importance of this day. We also completed a variety of Veterans Day activities in the classroom. Next up, Thanksgiving!

**Math-** 1st Quarter Week 7 Math Sheet - Complete one activity each night (**M - Th**). **Reading-** Read for 15 min./night. Please record the title of the book that was read each night. Additionally, for each completed book, your child will color in their reading log for the month (e.g. November books = Pumpkins). Don't forget the monthly reading challenge that was included in the binder as well. These activities are designed to motivate readers/encourage students to have fun with reading. It's optional, but highly recommended. **Word Study/Spelling-** Students should sort their Word Study/Spelling words each night as well as work on **3** activities total of their choosing from the Weekly Spelling Menu (**M - Th**, 10 min./night).
