Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students learned how to write effective summaries as well as how to find the main idea and supportive details in nonfiction texts. Our students improved and got better at this skill daily!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students began Ch. 3 which focuses on early American history locations and happenings such as Jamestown and the mystery of Roanoke Island. A big thank you to all of you for helping your child with materials and guidance for the diorama project. It was a huge success!

Math

In Math this week, we had fun practicing various ways to model multiplication; standard algorithm, partial product with area models and arrays, and using the distributive property just to name a few! We have also enjoyed incorporating multiplication in word problems, and solidifying our recall of basic multiplication facts 1-12.

Science

In Science this week we were busy with in-class reviews in preparation for our Chapter 4 test on the Human Body. We also began Chapter 5 which focuses on parts of and influences on various Ecosystems.

There will be a Chapter 5 Science Test on Thursday, 11/18.

Religion

In Religion this week we have been focused on God's mercy, healing, and forgiveness, through the Sacraments of Penance/Reconciliation and Anointing of the Sick. We have enjoyed finishing up our letters to our godparents (or someone who has inspired us in our faith) and have been focused on types of sins, and the conversion/repentance at the heart of Reconciliation.
