Social Studies

This Week: Students will be learning about the Andes Mountain Range, and will identify all the geographic features on their maps of South America. They will also work on completing a vocabulary flip book.

Next Week: Students will explore the continent of Africa and be introduced to three geographic features- The Nile River, Sahara Desert, and the Atlas Mountains.

Math

This Week: Students are learning addition using number patterns and compatible numbers as a strategy. They will learn how to add multiple digits with regrouping. They are also working on improving their fluency and accuracy with basic addition and subtraction skills using the website- mathtrainer.com

Next Week: Students are learning strategies to identify addition patterns and use partial sums to add three digit numbers.
