Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. **November 19th & 20th** will be the test dates for **all 50 states and capitals**. Students need to identify the correct state by shape/location and be able to write the state and capital name (spelling and capital letters count).

Math

We will continue to review multiplication and division all year long. We are beginning our unit on volume (V = $I \times w \times h$).

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 2nd qtr. requirements are to complete *Get ready for multiplication and division with whole numbers and decimals* (unit 4) and *Get ready for powers of 10* (unit 6). Students will work on Khan Academy as part of their extended math time.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued discussing and analyzing *Wonder*, and we worked with the list of spelling words (High Frequency Words, List #1). Students also took a quiz on possessive nouns.

Next week, we will finish reading *Wonder* and will have a test on the novel on Friday. We will also have a quiz on the spelling words on Thursday.

Theology

We continued working on the liturgical calendar this week, and next week students will create a liturgical calendar for 2024-2025 that will be graded as a project and will be displayed in various classrooms throughout the building. The new liturgical year starts on Sunday, December 1, with the first Sunday in Advent.

Science

We have begun our unit on atoms and elements. We will be researching and presenting on our chosen element. Look for details to come. This is completed mostly in class.
