Social Studies

We are focused on science this quarter.

Math

We started Unit 7 which includes understanding subtraction. We also continued to practice counting to 100! Some of them already know how to count to 100. At this time, the students are now expected to count to fifty. The students have also been counting to 100 by 2s, 5s and 10s. We have calendar time during math every day. The students continue to learn our days of the week song, months of the year song and seasons every day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. Please have your child read the books we send home every Friday to you three times to practice sight words and fluency. **Our sight words this week are: there, out, be, have, am. Next week's words are: do, did, what, so, get.**

Theology

Our kindergarteners learned about why the Lord's Prayer is important. They learned that during this prayer we ask God to give us all we need and forgive our sins. We also learned that he helps us forgive others and to avoid sin. Our students also learned about Saint James the Just. We talked about how God created four seasons. The students also spoke about what their favorite season was and why.

Science

We spoke about what plants need to live. They also drew pictures of what plants need as well as wrote the words next to the pictures. The students also started to create a Fall salt and glue project. We will finish it next week.
