Social Studies

Students say prayers and the Pledge of Allegiance each day. Students will learn about Native American Indians, Pilgrims, and Thanksgiving. This week, we learned about Pilgrims.

After Thanksgiving break, we will be doing our Christmas Around the World unit. This will include lots of crafts and fun activities.

Math

We continued our Math Journals this week. Each day we graph the weather for the day, add a number to our September calendar, draw a circle in our 180 day ten frame chart, and color in a number in our 100s chart. Students are learning to recognize and write numbers beyond 10. The students enjoy playing math games.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The focus this week was on short a word families. Students are learning to blend sounds to read

consonant-vowel-consonant words. We continued sight words this week: he, was, that, she, on. Next week, our sight words will be: they, but, at, with, all. Please continue to practice sight words at home. Students are working on pencil grip and writing on the lines. Students are learning the structure of Daily Five. As we send books home, please have your child point to each word and read the book three or more times. We are working hard to help students build independence by approaching tasks with the following guidelines: get started right away, work the whole time, stay in one spot, work quietly, build your stamina.
