

Curriculum

Math

We utilized the short week to review skills previously taught such as addition, subtraction, place value, and overall number sense. Next week we will continue with subtraction and key vocabulary such as difference, subtract, take from, take apart, how many fewer, and how many more. We will also continue to use strategies/instruction with manipulatives, drawing pictures, and using number lines to demonstrate subtraction number sentences.

Reading and Language Arts

<u>Reading</u>

Instead of our normal routine and a focus story of the week, we reviewed and practiced reading skills previously taught. This included, fiction vs. nonfiction, asking questions, retelling the story, and identifying characters, setting, and events (plot). Next week we will read the story, Maddi's Fridge and we will learn about text to world connections.

<u>Grammar</u>

This week we reviewed ending punctuation and ABC order. We discussed the process for organizing words based on a word's spelling/letter order (start by comparing words' first letter and then work your way to the right). Next week we will learn about common and proper nouns

Word Study/Spelling

We practiced sorting our words, chunking syllables, identifying phonemes (individual sounds) and focused on the /s/ sound. We looked at the spelling rules/generalizations for when and why /s/ is spelled with an s, ss, ce, ci, and cy. We also reviewed previously taught spelling patterns and skills. Next week students will receive a new word sort (spelling list).

<u>Writing</u>

This week we practiced our writing with a focus on ending punctuation. We also wrote within Daily 5 activity rotations and in other content areas such as Social Studies (Election Day), Religion, and morning work tasks.

Religion

This week we discussed All Saints Day, watched the Saints Program put on by the second graders and had an All Saints Day Mass. Next week we will continue learning about saints. We will start our "My ABC Saint Book" and learn about Pope Francis.

Science/ Social Studies

With Social Studies now being our focus for Q2, we kicked things off by discussing what it means to vote, the election process, and the recent elections from this past Tuesday. Next up, we will be completing activities around Veterans Day and Thanksgiving.

Math- 1st Quarter Week 6 Math Sheet - Complete one activity each night (**M - Th**). **Reading-** Read for 15 min./night. Please record the title of the book that was read each night. Additionally, for each completed book, your child will color in their reading log for the

month (e.g. November books = Pumpkins). Don't forget the monthly reading challenge that was included in the binder as well. These activities are designed to motivate readers/encourage students to have fun with reading. It's optional, but highly recommended. **Word Study/Spelling**- Students should sort their Word Study/Spelling words each night as well as work on **3** activities total of their choosing from the Weekly Spelling Menu (**M - Th**, 10 min./night).
