At this time, the students are now expected to count to fifty. The students have also been counting to 100 by 5s and 10s. Our students have also started to count by 2s. We have calendar time during math every day. The students continue to learn our days of the week song, months of the year song and seasons every day.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

The students are continuing to practice reading to self and work on writing. Please have your child read the books we send home every Friday to you three times to practice sight words and fluency. **Our sight words this week are: they, but, at, with, all. Next week's words are there, out, be, have, am.**

Theology
