Calendar/Important Dates

Please note that we will NOT have Mass on Tuesday, December 5. Instead, Mass will be on Friday, December 8 for the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

The Christmas Concert will be on December 13th, at 6:15. Students should be in their classrooms by 5:45 and no later than 6:00.

Science/Social Studies

Ms. Shank's class continued our study of animal adaptations. We studied adaptations of the polar bear. We learned how the color of their fur helps them camouflage to better hunt seals. We also learned that they have 4 inches of blubber to help them keep warm in the frigid arctic. We completed an experiment that simulated the polar bears blubber. The students first put their bare hands in a bucket of cold water with ice. Then they put their hand in a glove covered with Vaseline to simulate blubber. The students then determined what was the colder of the two. Next week we will learn about chameleon and penguin adaptations. Ms. Wawner's class learned about living and nonliving things this week and what special traits living things have. We learned that living things need food, water and air to survive, they move and grow, and they reproduce. Students made collages of living and nonliving things and went on a nature walk to identify living and nonliving things around our campus. Next week, we will start a unit on arctic animals, focusing on reindeer.

Math

Ms. Wawner's class learned about patterns this week, focusing on AB and ABC patterns. We made patterns with colors, shapes, sounds and movements. We will continue working with

patterns next week. Ms. Shank's class worked on ordinal numbers and will continue this next week.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on Gg this week and learned the sight word "see." Books have been sent home in the students' red folders. Please continue to help your child practice their sight words by asking them to read their book to you! Next week we will focus on the letter K and the sight word "a." Ms. Shank's class read a book called "Three Snow Bears" by Jan Brett. It is a different take on the Three Pigs. After reading we sequenced the story. Our letter work was the letter "Gg". Next week our reading groups will read books that contain the sight word " ______. Our letter work will be the letter "Mm". Our read aloud books will be from the "Tacky the Penguin" series. The students will all make their own Tacky the penguin for a craft.

<u>Theology</u>

Ms. Shank's and Ms. Wawner's classes talked about the meaning of Christmas and Advent. We will talk more about Advent next week, the meaning of the candles and how we can prepare for Advent. Both classes will have Advent wreaths in our classrooms.

- Even though the weather is turning colder, we will continue to get the students outside for recess as often as possible. Please make sure your child has the outerwear needed so that they can participate in recess. Below are the guidelines we follow:
 - Students should stay inside if the wind-chill factor is below 25°F.
 - If the wind-chill is in the 30s, students should have a coat (not a sweatshirt) and it should be encouraged that their heads are covered (hat or cinched coat/sweatshirt hood).
 - If the wind-chill is in the 40s, students should at least have a sweatshirt on.
 - Students who do not have the proper outerwear will sit in the front office for recess.
