Language Arts

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students completed a project in which they researched and created flags to represent what life was like for the Jamestown settlers. Students also began Ch.4 in our text which details how Virginia grew and changed in the 1600-1760's.

Math

In Math this week we started Division. We learned how to estimate quotients using the zero property, how to model division in base-10, and used our problem solving skills to solve word problems with division operations.

Science

In Science this week we enjoyed our test prep/review for the Chapter 6 test- "Energy Transfer in Ecosystems". We were busy utilizing class time to continue working on our Ecosystem projects. We look forward to presenting these next week.
