We continued our unit on subtraction strategies. We worked on decomposing, using the number line and using tens and ones to subtract.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we learned about holidays around the world. Please ask your child what holiday was their favorite. We also continued reading our whole class read aloud called <u>The Family Under the Bridge</u> by Natalie Savage Carlson. The story is about finding family in the unlikeliest of places during the holiday season.

In writing, students have been continuing to work on writing using complete sentences. We have been focusing on the writing process by prewriting, writing drafts, editing and revising and writing final drafts. We created "ugly" Christmas sweaters. The students wrote why they think their sweater is amazing, as we will vote next week on our favorite sweater.

In grammar, we focused on using adjectives in our writing. Ask your child about the kindness activity we did.

In Mrs. Bryan's class, in writing we continued working on writing a diary as an elf, so we have several daily entries for these. We have also started working on an informative writing booklet for Selling a Home at the North Pole.

Theology

This week we continued learning about some stories from the bible and added an ornament that represents the stories to our Jesse Tree. We also have been continuing to learn about the

advent season and sharing our traditions during this time of year. Next week, we will focus on the birth of Jesus and create a nativity scene to hang on our school windows.
