On behalf of the middle school team, we would like to wish you a Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year. Please note that our last day of school is Tuesday, December 19th, and <u>school will</u> <u>be closed from Wednesday, December 20th - Tuesday, January 2nd. We return to school on Wednesday, January 3rd.</u>

- On Monday, December 18th, students will complete their midterm examinations. (For those students still needing to make-up midterms, they will be expected to take those assessments when they return from break, during their block classes on Wednesday and Thursday)
- On Tuesday, December 19th, we will have our Middle School FANS event to go see the movie "ELF" at the Regal Cinema (students will return from the movie prior to car line, so normal middle school pickup will happen)

Here are some key dates when we return from Christmas Break:

Even though the weather is turning colder, we will continue to get the students outside for recess as often as possible. Please make sure your child has the outerwear needed so that they can participate in recess. Below are the guidelines we follow:

- $\circ~$  Students should stay inside if the wind-chill factor is below 25°F.
- If the wind-chill is in the 30s, students should have a coat (not a sweatshirt) and it should be encouraged that their heads are covered (hat or cinched coat/sweatshirt hood).
- If the wind-chill is in the 40s, students should at least have a sweatshirt on.
- Students who do not have the proper outerwear will sit in the front office for recess.
