# Junior Kindergarten

### <u>Math</u>

Ms. Shank's class spent the week on the concept of symmetry. We studied snowflakes and snow, (snowflakes are symmetrical). We painted half a butterfly and then folded it in half so the paint pattern would be the same. They look beautiful. When we return we will be focusing on graphing with concrete objects and with worksheets. We will even do a skittle sort and graph. We continue to graph our weekly question. We will also be reviewing numbers 11-20. I will be assessing the students whether they can identify the number and count groups to those numbers. I will assess them sometime in January. Ms. Wawner's class focused on patterns this week. We had fun creating patterns with our bodies, voices, items around the classroom, stickers and beads.

## Language Arts/Reading/Writing

Ms. Wawner's class focused on the sight words go and it this week, while reviewing our sight words from last week. Students enjoyed hunting for sight words around the classroom and in books and playing the bean bag game. We focused on the letter K, and will continue our study of letters when we return from the break. Ms. Shank's class loved our author study of Jan Brett. Many of her books fit with the Christmas spirit. We also fell in love with her hedgehog that is an inspiration for many of her books. We worked on the letter K and continued with our reading groups. When we return we will continue to read a book with the sight word TO. I am focusing on a sight word a week according to their frequency.

## <u>Religion</u>

In Ms. Shank's class the students really enjoyed our daily Jesse Tree readings. Each student had a bulb to add to our "tree". We read about the meaning of each bulb and said prayers. We had a wonderful celebration of Our Lady of Guadalupe. Ms. Wawner's class learned about the Christmas Story. When we return we will learn about Daniel and the lions, how he trusted in God.

## Science/Social Studies

Ms. Wawner's class completed their study of the Arctic Reindeer. We answered all our questions that students posed at the beginning of the unit: where do they live, what do they eat, what do they do, how do they survive in the cold? We culminated with a craft project that we hope you will enjoy!

Ms. Shank's class leaned a lot about snow and snowflakes. When we return we will begin a unit on what animals do in Winter, (hibernation, migration, and adaptation). We will study bears, monarch butterflies, and the arctic hare. We will also be investigating ice with lots of experiments and activities.
