Week in Review

Language Arts

In Language Arts this week, students learned how to start writing realistic fiction stories and personal narratives based on finding moments of "strong feeling" from their own lives. Students also participated in creating believable characters with struggles and dreams. They are becoming fantastic writers!

Social Studies

In Social Studies this week, students completed a project in which they researched and created flags to represent what life was like for the Jamestown settlers. Students also researched different locations in Virginia such as Henricus Historical Park and the actual Jamestown site location!

Math

In Math this week we have been focused on multiplication by two-digit numbers and multi-step word problems. We have been working on our computation, critical thinking and problem solving skills!

Science

In Science this week we have been focused on energy transfer in ecosystems. We have learned all about producers, consumers (carnivores, herbivores, omnivores), and decomposers. We have been studying food pyramids and food chains, and various ways plants and animals obtain energy within their Ecosystem. We have also been studying animals' niches and the predator/prey relationships within their unique habitats.

Religion

In Religion we have been enveloped in the first week of Advent. We've enjoyed our daily readings and devotionals. We began Unit 3 Lesson 11 in our books, and have reflected on what it means to be created in God's image and likeness- highlighting our human dignity, and human rights.
