

- <u>Christmas Concerts</u> There are 2 separate Christmas concerts for students this year. The 3rd-5th Grade concert is on Wednesday, December 18, and the JK-2nd Grade concert is on Thursday, December 19. Both concerts start at 6:15PM.
 - Important concert night information:
 - Students should arrive at their classrooms between 5:40PM and 5:55PM.
 When they arrive, they are to go directly to their classrooms. Parents should go directly to the gym upon arrival.
 - At the end of both concerts, K-5 students will return to their homerooms.
 Parents must sign their children out with their teachers.
 - JK students will be dismissed after they sing.

Social Studies

This Week: Students will learn facts about the Nile River, Sahara Desert, and Atlas Mountains. They will draw and label these geographic features on their maps of Africa and paste the map in their passports. They will also work on completing their vocabulary flip book.

Next Week: Students will explore the continent of Asia and be introduced to the Huang He River, Himalayas, and Gobi Desert. They will draw and label these geographic features on their maps of Asia and paste the map in their passports.

Math

This Week:. Students will learn strategies to subtract three digit numbers using mental math. They will continue to explore relationships between addition and subtraction.

Next Week: Students will learn to adjust numbers to add or subtract three digit numbers. They will also learn how to use inverse operation to check their subtraction process.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This Week:

We completed our Reading Unit on Understanding Characters and began our Novel Study on The Christmas Pig. We will look to use these reading skills, as well as other language skills, as we follow Jack and his friends on an adventure to find his lost stuffed animal, DP. Analyzing characters, making inferences, and summarizing the text will continue to be important skills for us as readers moving forward.

Science

This Week: Students will learn the process of photosynthesis and the different types of plants located in ecosystems. Students will work on completing their vocabulary foldable.

Next Week: Students will be introduced to different habitats located in ecosystems and the types of organisms found in each ecosystem. They will also begin working on a packet containing the life cycle of plants. They will continue observing and measuring the growth of their seedlings.
