Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be exploring the events leading up to the Revolutionary War.

Math

We are going to be starting our unit on dividing decimals. The key words students will be using are *"over, over, up".*

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (<u>khanacademy.org</u>). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 2nd qtr. requirements are to complete *Get ready for multiplication and division with whole numbers and decimals* (unit 4) and *Get ready for powers of 10* (unit 6). Students will work on Khan Academy as part of their extended math time.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we started reading several short stories and focusing on the concepts of main idea and supporting details. We also had a quiz on collective nouns, and students received a new list of spelling/vocabulary words from one of the short stories we read.

Next week, students will have a quiz on main ideas/supporting details and a test on the spelling/vocabulary words. We will also focus on nouns as subjects and subject complements in grammar, and students will have a quiz on that material by the end of the week.

The two IRAs are due Monday, January 6. Please let me know if you or your student would like a hard copy of any of the slides for this project so they can handwrite, rather than type, the project.

Theology

Students finished creating their liturgical calendars, and we started a unit on Advent. Students will have a quiz on that short unit next week.

Science

Students did an amazing job on their element presentations. Next we will be learning about earth's structures and topography.

We will also be making a conservation project using empty 2 liter bottles. Please send in any empty 2 liter bottles if you can. We are 14 bottles short to do this project.
