Teacher's Message/Announcements

- CCS Christmas Concerts 3rd-5th Grade concert is on Tuesday, December 12 and the JK-2nd Grade concert is on Wednesday, December 13. Both concerts start at 6:15PM-students will need to arrive at school between 5:40PM and 5:55PM.
- Even though the weather is turning colder, we will continue to get the students outside
 for recess as often as possible. Please make sure your child has the outerwear needed
 so that they can participate in recess. Below are the guidelines we follow:
 - Students should stay inside if the wind-chill factor is below 25°F.
 - If the wind-chill is in the 30s, students should have a coat (not a sweatshirt) and it should be encouraged that their heads are covered (hat or cinched coat/sweatshirt hood).
 - o If the wind-chill is in the 40s, students should at least have a sweatshirt on.
 - Students who do not have the proper outerwear will sit in the front office for recess.
- Friday, December 15 is our Tacky Christmas Sweater Day at CCS! Students will be allowed to wear appropriate tacky Christmas sweaters to school that day.
 - Students in K-5 may wear either their school uniform jumpers or pants, or CCS sweatpants.
 - Middle School students may wear school uniform skirts or pants, blue jeans, or CCS sweatpants.
 - All students must wear their uniform shoes.
 - Any students not participating must wear their normal uniform.

Social Studies

This week students will complete a vocabulary foldable, and be introduced to our next continent Asia. They will explore and learn about ancient empires, as well as, the geographic features; The Huang He River, Himalayas, and Gobi Desert.

Next week students will learn facts about the continent of Asia. They will explore and learn about three geographic features; The Huang He River, Himalayas, and Gobi Desert. Students will also draw and label the geographic features on a map for their passport.

Math

This week students are learning how to round three and four digit numbers to the nearest ten and hundred, then adding the estimates together to understand an estimated sum.

Next week students will learn how to use place value when adding three and four digit numbers with regrouping, and how to make a reasonable estimate.. They will also be introduced to algebra by learning the three properties of addition; commutative, associative, and identity.

Theology

This Week:

It was a busy week in Theology. We continued preparing for the next Mass that 3rd grade will lead (Tuesday, 12/19) as well as practiced for our Christmas Concert (Tuesday, 12/12). We also celebrated the beginning of the liturgical season of Advent (Hope), which is a time of preparation, a time of joyful and hopeful waiting, and a time to make space in our hearts to receive Jesus!

Next Week:

Science

This week students will be introduced to the planets in our solar system, and learn about the differences of the inner and outer planets, sun, and constellations. They will begin working on their vocabulary foldable involving the solar system.

Next week students will learn about the order of our planets, and the kind of objects found in our universe. They will learn facts about the eight primary planets and the constellations forming a pattern of stars. Students will also learn about star patterns changing with the seasons.
