Teacher's Message/Announcements:

- We will be watching the movie *Wonder* on Friday, December 15, after we have a test on the novel. This movie is rated PG, so we will be sending an email allowing you to opt your child out of this movie, so please look for that early next week.
- Even though the weather is turning colder, we will continue to get the students outside for recess as often as possible. Please make sure your child has the outerwear needed so that they can participate in recess. Below are the guidelines we follow:
 - Students should stay inside if the wind-chill factor is below 25°F.
 - If the wind-chill is in the 30s, students should have a coat (not a sweatshirt) and it should be encouraged that their heads are covered (hat or cinched coat/sweatshirt hood).
 - If the wind-chill is in the 40s, students should at least have a sweatshirt on.

Students who do not have the proper outerwear will sit in the front office for recess.

- **Please save and send in empty 2 liter bottles (rinsed please) for science.
- The new lunch company will not begin providing lunches until after the Christmas break, so please continue to be sure to pack a lunch for your child for all of December.
- Friday, December 15 is our Tacky Christmas Sweater Day at CCS! Students will be allowed to wear appropriate tacky Christmas sweaters to school that day.
 - Students in K-5 may wear either their school uniform jumpers or pants, or CCS sweatpants.

- Middle School students may wear school uniform skirts or pants, blue jeans, or CCS sweatpants.
- o All students must wear their uniform shoes.
- Any students not participating must wear their normal uniform.

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Social Studies

In history we will be learning about early US history and how we came to be a nation. We will be learning about the causes of the American Revolution.

Math

We have been learning about volume, composite figures and cubic units. We will be learning about dividing with decimals. Remind your child when they get stuck,:over, over, up:.

To reinforce math concepts and skills, students are assigned sections for Khan Academy (khanacademy.org). This is for a grade. Students have their login and password in their planner. The 2nd qtr. requirements, **due before the end of the quarter** are Multiplying & dividing whole numbers and decimals (unit 4) and Adding and subtracting fractions (unit 3).

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week we continued reading *Wonder* and continued focusing on characterization. We continued working on the essay associated with the book, and had a quiz on collective nouns.

Next week we will finish reading and annotating *Wonder*, and we will have a test on the novel on Wednesday. The banner project will also be due on Wednesday. Students will also turn in the revised draft of the essay connected to *Wonder*, and they will watch the movie *Wonder* on Friday.

Theology

This week students had a test on the liturgical calendar and Advent. Next week, they will begin a short unit on Catholic creeds and have a test on the Apostle's Creed on Tuesday, December 19.

Science

We are going to be learning about states of matter and atoms. We have a few fun labs coming up. We will be conducting a density lab. This activity can be recreated at home for fun if you would like - with adult supervision.
