Social Studies

This week in Social Studies, students finished chapter 3 which focused on Jamestown and early settlers. Math

In Math this week we took our Chapter 5 test on 2-by-2 digit multiplication, and have started Ch. 6. We are moving from multiplication to division. We have enjoyed understanding the relationship between the two, and feel confident to tackle division in the coming weeks.

Language Arts/Reading/Writing

This week in Language Arts, students continued into our unit that consists of a research project regarding natural disasters! This is a great unit in which nonfiction texts will be used. Students also learned how to summarize and identify the main idea of nonfiction texts.

Religion

In Religion we've reflected on what it means to be a member of the Church, and have been focused on the importance of the Sacraments of Initiation, and Reconciliation. We were fortunate to have the opportunity to attend Reconciliation here at school. We took our quiz on Unit 2 Lesson 8 and look forward to learning more about the Sacraments of Healing next week in Unit 2 Lesson 9.

Science
