The exam review packet was due this Friday and will be given back to the kids on Monday, December 12th after it has been graded. Algebra (Reid): This past week the kids took their 2nd test of the 2nd Quarter on Slope & Graphing Lines. The rest of the week we continued to prepare for our 1st semester Algebra 1 exam. The kids turned in their Algebra 1 Exam Review Packet on Friday, December 9th. They had digital access to this document before Thanksgiving and were given a paper copy last week. These will be returned to the kids on Monday, December 12th after they have been graded. Eighth Grade Algebra 1 students will take their exam on Tuesday, December 13th. Seventh Grade Algebra 1 students will take their exam on Thursday, December 15th.
